Job Summary:

Under the general direction of the Director of Learning and Engagement, the Research and Evaluation Specialist will work closely with museum educators and curators to develop and manage all aspects of program evaluation and outcomes/measurement framework. These responsibilities will provide the museum a clear understanding of the impact of its outreach programs, Neighborhood Engagement Program, school tours, DOE professional development, and exhibitions. The Research and Evaluation Specialist will review existing literature, develop evaluation design, organize data collection and analysis, and maintain quality control of evaluation processes.
